Rosi Kerr is the Director of Behavioral Programs for EnergyClimate Solutions. She has been working in the environmental space for more than ten years. Rosi worked first as an environmental educator where her passion for the environment was matched by her passion for enabling students to become proactive participants in positive environmental change.

After teaching environmental science at the Mountain School of Milton Academy and the Vermont Institute of Natural Science, Rosi went to graduate school at Yale. As her understanding of environmental problems deepened, Rosi became convinced that how we consume energy and the type of energy we consume has to change to solve some of our most pressing environmental problems. She also became committed to helping to drive market-based solutions to these problems. During her graduate research in a small fishing town in Alaska, Rosi noticed townspeople consistently pointed out two environmental problems: local pollution from fish processing plants and concerns about fuel for the off-grid local energy system. Rosi and a team of colleagues at Yale developed a plan to convert offal from fish processing plants into a local biofuel source, effectively solving both problems.

After completing her degree, Rosi jumped into the commercial energy markets. At Juice Energy Inc. in New York City, Rosi helped develop the company from a small startup to a major player in the markets it served. Rosi was integral in developing marketing approaches, environmental product design and managing high-level client relationships. Rosi also led the sales team in gross sales.

Rosi graduated from Dartmouth College with a BA in English Literature. She has a Master in Environmental Science from the Yale University School of Forestry and Environmental Studies. She is actively involved in Gray Is Green, a nonprofit dedicated to helping people over 65 engage in the climate change movement. Rosi has led and participated in expeditions in Alaska and the Canadian Arctic, and guided rafting and horsepacking trips. She is an avid rower, runner and cyclist and spends her weekends adventuring in the White Mountains.
